Dodson & Horrell Ltd Environment & Sustainability Policy Statement

Dodson & Horrell Ltd was established in 1939 and is a recognised leader in the manufacture and marketing of specialist equine feeds, whilst also producing canine diets and other pet foods, herbal blends and a range of traditional animal feeds which includes diets for camels, ostriches and other exotics. These products are manufactured using selected wholesome raw materials to ensure that our products are of the highest nutritional quality. We work closely with local farmers who are contracted to grow quality accredited crops. We were honoured to be granted a Royal Warrant of Appointment as manufacturers for both horse feed (1985) and Chudleys dog food (2006) to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, of which we are immensely proud.

Dodson & Horrell recognises the importance of environmental protection and sustainability and is committed to operating responsibly in compliance with all legal requirements. The policy is to carry out all reasonably practicable measures to meet, and where possible exceed, environmental requirements including those for local residents, the Environment Agency, East Northants Council Environmental Protection Officers and ISO 14001. Individual Environmental Objectives, including those with the following aims, are reviewed at Management Review:

- Understanding, control and communication of the effect of D&H activities for local residents
- Assessment and monitoring of environmental key performance indicators
- Promotion of efficiency and minimisation of waste of energy and water during manufacture
- Promotion of the use of sustainable materials e.g. reuse of pallets, purchase of palm oil products that meet sustainability criteria, use of nutritious by-products from human food manufacture which would not otherwise be consumed and would therefore add to industry waste
- Segregation at source to facilitate the following waste hierarchy:
 - Minimisation of waste produced by efficient processing
 - Rework where it is suitable to do so nutritionally and hygienically
 - Sending out as surplus for appropriate species when suitable to do so nutritionally and hygienically e.g. cattle, pigs, sheep (low mineral content) for feed surplus and pets for pet surplus
 - Recycling of packaging materials such as cardboard, shrink wrap and tote bags
 - Sending feed and pet feeds with nutrition or hygiene issues for biofuel
 - Sent out as general waste to zero to landfill contractor
- Reduction and/or limitation of air emissions, noise emissions and discharges to water
- Practical development of systems to improve environmental performance
