

High Fibre Nuts Composition

Oatfeed; Dried Beet Pulp; Wheatfeed; Grass Meal; Molasses; Sodium Chloride; Dicalcium Phosphate; Calcium Carbonate.

Feeding Rate

Feed 400g-1kg/100kg bodyweight per day in conjunction with free access to forage. Do not exceed 1kg/100kg bodyweight per day in total. Divide into at least 2-3 meals per day.

Ensure a minimum intake of 2kg/100kg bodyweight of forage per day.

Fresh drinking water must be available at all times.

*a non heating feed is one that is less likely to produce excitable behaviour in some horses and ponies when fed at the recommended rate
